Anti-psychotic Drug REduction in primary care for Adults with Learning Disabilities (ANDREA-LD): A Randomised Double-blind Placebo Controlled Trial

CURRENTLY RECRUITING PRACTICES AND GPs

We are currently looking to recruit GPs who are interested in becoming Principal Investigators. The Trial is currently in set up at Cardiff University and we aim to start recruiting participants in March/April 2014.

The aim of the trial is to evaluate whether the mental health and behaviour of adults with learning disabilities is affected by the gradual withdrawal of their anti-psychotic medication.

The trial will be open to adults with learning disabilities who are currently taking one of two anti-psychotic drugs - risperidone or haloperidol - for treatment of challenging behaviour with no known psychosis.
